A prospective debutante should:

- Submit a completed application form
- Submit five (5) 5" x 7" high resolution digital photos no later than March 1, 2015
- * A debutante arranges hotel reservations at the Waldorf Astoria as soon as her application is processed
- A debutante selects and arranges a white floor-length gown and white full-length gloves as appropriate for the dress
- The debutante and her family select and arrange for a civilian escort for the debutante
- The debutantes attend *Le Grande Luncheon*, where they are introduced to their patroness, other debutantes, and dignitaries
